- ❖ The nominee must be female and over the age of 18 (nominee categories on second page).
- ❖ Females between the ages of 16-18 may be nominated for the Young Shero Award. They must be a **high school senior**.
- ❖ The nominee must demonstrate where she has improved the lives of women by giving them the resources, they need to improve their education, skills, and employment prospects and or has improved the quality of life for an identifiable group.
- ❖ The nominee must be a legal resident of the CSRA 15 County jurisdiction.

- If there are no entries and/ or there is not a score high enough in a particular category, no award will be given in that said category.
- No nominee will win more than one award each year. For example, if a
 nominee scores highest in two categories, the nominating committee
 has the discretion to pick one of the two categories that best
 recognizes her achievements. In that case the nominee with the
 second highest score will receive the other award provided she has the
 min. score required.

SHERO Award Nomination Categories

<u>Arts</u> - An Arts professional that demonstrates a commitment to the arts and demonstrates excellence in the Art field.

Business - A Business professional that serves as a role model for young girls and demonstrates excellence in a leadership capacity in a small, medium or large company or corporation.

<u>Community Service</u> - A non-professional and or a non-profit professional that demonstrates a long standing commitment to the welfare of others, while demonstrating a willingness to collaborate and improve the quality of life of persons in the community.

<u>Education</u> -An educator or one who works in the education profession that serves as a role model for young girls and demonstrates excellence in a leadership capacity in the education field.

<u>Faith & Spirituality</u> - A Woman of faith that demonstrates a dedicated commitment to sharing her faith and impacting the quality of life of others through her faith.

<u>Health & Social Services</u> - A health professional that demonstrates excellence and or commitment to the health field and to the livelihood, welfare, and wellbeing of patients.

<u>Law & Government</u> - Law or Government professional who has demonstrated a career committed to justice, liberty, and fairness to all in the community in law & government.

<u>Armed Forces</u> - Armed Forces professional who has demonstrated a career committed to justice, liberty, and fairness to all in the community and in the armed forces.

<u>Young Shero</u> - A high-school teen girl (16-18) who demonstrates that she is dedicated to improving the quality of life for others in school, church, or other extracurricular activities. She has been able to overcome an obvious obstacle in her life. This is a new award given by Sisters Only Club and should go to a teenage girl who is a role model for other teenage girls. *Nominee must be a High School Senior.*



<u>96.3 Kiss FM Vision Award</u> - A woman that demonstrates foresight and vision in creating a plan of action for a service project that will have a long-standing positive impact on the. *This is the second highest honor given by Sisters Only Club, the highest being the Woman of the Year.*

<u>Shero Award Woman of the Year</u>- A woman in the community, who demonstrates that she is well rounded, in career, family life, faith and service to community shall be eligible as a nominee for Woman of the Year. *This is the highest honor given by Sisters Only Club and should go to a woman that young girls can look up to as a role model and woman whom others can look to as a mentor.*

<u>Vermell Best Mother of the Year</u>- Created in memory of *Vermell Best*, a remarkable woman whose life exemplified grace, resilience, and generosity, this award recognizes mothers who embody her enduring legacy of love and service.

Recipients of this award are chosen not only for their dedication to their families, but also for their impact on their communities—women who, like Vermell, wear many hats and carry heavy loads with dignity and purpose. They inspire those around them, lead with compassion, and model the true meaning of motherhood.
